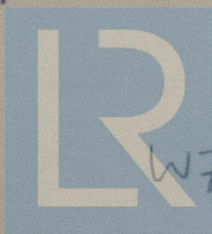
Extract from letter dated 18th Jan, 1913. received from
The Surveyor, HAVRE

Vessel's Name S "VILLE d'ALGER" & "ILE de la REUNION"

Sir,

In receipt of your letter of the 14th instant reverting to three lengths of chain cable which were transferred from the yacht "ILE de la REUNION" on the s/s "VILLE d'ALGER" I beg to submit to you that the Owners have ordered three new lengths of chain cable 17 fath. each 2-1/16" diameter to be placed on board "VILLE d'ALGER"- but to allow the s/s "ILE de la REUNION" to proceed on her voyage with full equipment these three lengths will be placed provisionally on board of s/s "ILE de la REUNION" the 1st February next during her call at Marseilles.

To definitively replace the things in order at next opportunity, the two vessels will exchange between them the three lengths at Marseilles. As these vessels never meet in Havre the Owner thinks better to have equipment replaced on the proper vessels at Marseilles. The local surveyor is fully informed by me about the fact.
