Précis of particulars of Casualty The Germans claim that this vessel was bombed and sunk 300 miles N.W. of Ireland on the 31st January, 1941.

She left Freetown on the 10th January for Oban and has not been heard of since.

The Admiralty have advised that she must be presumed sunk by enemy action.
