Précis of particulars of Casualty

This vessel was reported to have put into Barbados leaky on 17<sup>th</sup> February. All cargo was discharged. It was stated that "41" hanging knees were started, scarfs in keelson sister keelson out of place, four planks water line wormed, topside and deck need caulking, covering boards strained seriously. Must dock for repairs. Surveyors recommended condemnation as constructive total loss. The vessel was being advertised for sale by auction on 27<sup>th</sup> Octo per the reply has yet been received to a special casualty letter addressed to the Owners.

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

NINON L. (s.v.).—Barbados, Feb. 17. — British schooner Ninon L., with pitch-pine, put in here leaky; lost part of deck-load.

NINON L. (s.v.).—Barbados, Mar. 5. — Schooner Ninon L.: Evidently worked very badly. Leaking at the rate of 3 in. per hour. Survey has been held and discharge of cargo recommended, further survey. Owners have instructed master discharge cargo Mar. 2. Jettisoned portion of deckload, remainder water soaked, under deck not yet reached. Our opinion will be difficult after serious expense and delay vessel to reach destination. Under the circumstances think it advisable tranship cargo another vessel. — Lloyd's Agents per Salvage Association.

NINON L. (s.v.).—Barbados, Mar. 11. — Schooner Ninon L.: Discharge will be completed probably about Mar. 31, when survey will be held. As far as can be ascertained cargo in fair condition. — Salvage Association.

NINON L. (s.v.).—Barbados, Apr. 5. — Schooner Ninon L.: All the cargo has been discharged. Surveyors report making no water amidships but forward sounding indicates leaking at the rate of 5 in. per hour, difference on account of serious camber 18 in. keelson. Forty-one hanging knees started, scarfs in keelson sister keelson out of place, four planks water-line wormed, topsides and deck need caulking, covering boards strained, other damages and hull strained seriously. Must go into dock for repairs. Surveyors recommend condemnation constructive total loss. — Lloyd's Agent per Salvage Association.

NINON L. (s.v.).—Barbados, Oct. 17. — Schooner Ninon L. is advertised for sale by auction on Oct. 27. — Salvage Association.
