Your classing letter of 20th. Instant duly received and as requested herewith please find enclosed rough sketch of position of electric weldings in cargo tank Nos. 2 & 5.

With regard to deck fastening of bulkhead between fuel tank and N°4 cargo tank, an attempt was made to weld up this part, but was found too awkward to effect, so rivets were set up and caulked and all found tight at the water test.
