Dear Sir,

With reference to London letter of the 23rd instant regarding record of bulkheads for the Steamer "COYLET", I beg to state that there are 11 watertight bulkheads in this vessel, counting the engine and boiler room (cofferdam) bulkheads and following the practice in oil carrying vessels it appears the record should be 11 bulkheads. If the cofferdam bulkheads are not counted the record should be 9 bulkheads. The plan of this vessel forwarded with report indicates the bulkheads and as there have been other vessels of this type built, of which we have no particulars, the record for the "COYLET" might be left for London to decide in accordance with precedent.
