Sir,

With reference to Glasgow Report No. 41069 which is being forwarded to-day on the Steamer "COYLET" ex "WAZIRISTAN", I beg to acquaint you that in the special circumstances of this case the Glasgow Committee recommend that an inclusive fee of £150 should be charged for the services of the Surveyor in connection with the fitting of cylindrical tanks for carrying petroleum, and I shall be glad to know whether this will be approved.

It is intended that this fee should include the Special Survey No. 3 both on the hull and on the machinery, but that in addition a fee of £10:10/- should be charged for the damage repairs to the hull and £5:5/- for the damage survey of the machinery, as well as a fee of £10 for the assignment of freeboard.
