Sir,

With reference to Glasgow Report No.41069 which is being forwarded to-day on the Steamer "COYLET" ex "WAZIRISTAN", I beg to acquaint you that in the special circumstances of this case the Glasgow Committee recommend that an inclusive fee of £150 should be charged for the services of the Surveyor in connection with the fitting of cylindrical tanks for carrying petroleum, and I shall be glad to know whether this will be approved.

It is intended that this fee should include the Special Survey No.3 both on the hull and on the machinery, but that in addition a fee of £10:10/- should be charged for the damage repairs to the hull and £5:5/- for the damage survey of the machinery, as well as a fee of £10 for the assignment of freeboard.
