It will be seen that on the whole the anchors are
23 lbs light which is about $\frac{1}{10}$ th of 1 per cent but the
stocks are slightly more than one fourth the weight of the
anchors, thus making up the deficiency.

It is submitted that in view of the slight deficiency
the anchors merit the favorable consideration of the Committee
