In March, 1911 the Owner asked that this vessel might be allowed to run until February 1912 without being remetalled etc. She was perfectly tight and the metal in excellent condition. He added that she was chartered from Liverpool to Gibraltar and thence to Newfoundland and on her return he would have the Half-Time Survey held.

In the circumstances, this proposal was agreed to by the Committee.

In reply to a further enquiry the Owner stated that in moderate despatch the vessel ought to arrive in England about the end of March or the beginning of April. The Owner now states that the
