

In March last the Owner asked that this vessel might be allowed until February 1912 without being remetalled etc. as she was very tight and the metal in excellent condition. He added that the vessel returned from Liverpool to Gibraltar and thence to Newfoundland and on her return he would have the Half Time Survey held. In circumstances this proposal was agreed to by the Committee.

In reply to inquiry the Owner now writes that with moderate speed the vessel ought to arrive in England about the end of March or beginning of April. He expects the vessel to arrive at Bahia and thence she will proceed to Trinidad in ballast to load for
