M. I have to inform you that the S.S. "TIDAL", Messrs Colby Brothers' No.107, is proceeding to your port in order to receive her machinery, and to complete the survey for classification the following remains to be done, viz:-

The engine casings to be riveted and the poop deck hose tested, steam pump suction, windlass and steering gear to be tried, forward machinery space watertight bulkhead to be tested, and the hand pump connection to the deck on port side, which was found to be leaking when the decks were tested before the vessel left the Builders' yard, to be hose tested.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to your satisfaction, to forward a report on form No.8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
