The Engine Casings to be riveted and Poop deck hose tested.

Steam pump suction, windlass and steering gear to be tried.

Forward machinery space W.T. Bulkhead to be tested.

Hand pump, ^{connection} ~~suctions~~ to deck on port side aft, to be hose tested, this was found to be leaking when the decks were tested before the vessel left.
