Nature of Survey

The class of this vessel is subject to a special survey equal to a half time survey being held at four and eight years from date of build, to a stream anchor of proper weight and test being supplied, and the remainder of the equipment of anchors and cables being examined and found or placed in order.

The Newcastle Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated.

The bottom ^{up to above the turn of bilge has been recaulked and} ~~and several~~ topside strakes ~~have been~~ recaulked as found necessary and minor repairs effected.

A bower anchor and 60 fathoms of chain cable of proper weight and test supplied.

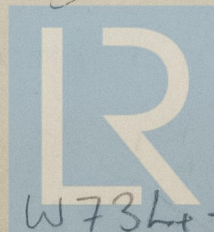
It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 7.20, as recommended, subject to a stream anchor of proper weight and test being supplied and the chain cables being ranged and examined and found or placed in order, and to a special survey equal to a half time survey being held at four and eight years from date of build.
