Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 27th ultimo, respecting the case of the Ferro-Concrete Dumb Barge "CRETEHAVEN" recently completed at Greenock by Messrs. The Scottish Concrete Ship Co., Ltd., and with regard thereto have to inform you that accounts have to-day been rendered to the Accountant General, Ministry of Shipping, for the fees due for the survey during construction, and for the survey and assignment of freeboard of this vessel, as under:-

For survey of Hull.....	£113: 5: 0
" " " Donkey Boiler.....	9: 9: 0
" " " and assignment of freeboard	2: 2: 0

Of the fee for the survey of the hull, £90:12:0 will be credited to your port, and the balance of £22:13:0 to the Greenock Office, together with the freeboard fee of £2:2:0 and one-third of the Donkey Boiler fee, viz:-£3:3:0. The balance of the Donkey Boiler fee will be due to this Office for the survey during construction at the makers' works.

I enclose for your information a copy of a letter I have to-day addressed to the Greenock Surveyors respecting this case.

I may add that the Classification certificate has been sent direct to the Ministry of Shipping in this case.
