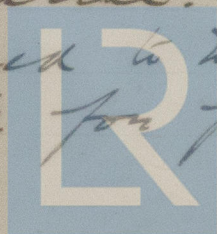
Messrs. Burnley Ironworks

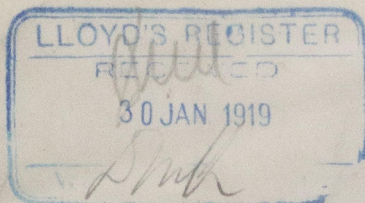
