Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that the S.S. "SCIENTIST" built by Messrs. Lithgows Limited for Messrs. T. & J. Harrison, Ltd., has left this Port last night for Liverpool.

During the trial trip yesterday an accident occurred to the hand steering gear which is of the friction type and constructed by Brown Bros. of Edinburgh.

Owing to the arrangements for loading it was necessary for the vessel to proceed to Liverpool and a temporary second means of steering was fitted before leaving this Port.

This steering gear will be repaired in Liverpool before the vessel sets out on her voyage and it should be tested on completion of the repairs.

I shall be glad if you could give this your attention.

I may add that the first entry report on this vessel has not yet been forwarded to the head office, but the class of the vessel will be subject to the hand steering gear being repaired and tested before the vessel proceeds on her voyage.
