Messrs. Brown Bros. & Co.Ld. - Plan of Forged Steel
Tiller for Messrs. Lithgows' Yard No.911.

I return herewith two copies of the above plan submitted with your letter of the 19th instant and with regard thereto I have to inform you that it is observed that a friction hand gear is proposed to be arranged as the alternative means of steering. This will be approved in this case, provided it can be demonstrated to the Surveyors' satisfaction that the vessel can be readily navigated with the friction clutch hand gear.

Further, the scantlings and arrangements as shown on the plan will be approved, provided they be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors and the Forging be tested as required by the Rules.

One copy of the plan should be forwarded to the Surveyors in whose district the Forging is to be made and they should be requested to forward the same to the Greenock Surveyors when finished with.
