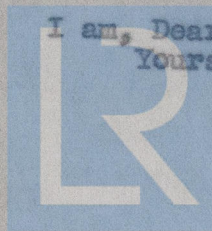
I am returning to you under separate cover two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 26th ultimo, of General Pumping Arrangement proposed for Yard No.911 building by Messrs. Lithgows, Ltd., and have to inform you that this plan will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon and the remaining requirements of Section 34 of the Rules (1936-7) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is noted that the total cross-sectional area of the ballast tank air pipes is less than that of the respective filling connections. It is therefore concluded that, as in the case of previous similar vessels, a special overboard discharge is fitted to the tank filling main in order to prevent the tanks being subjected to excessive pressure when they are being pumped up.

The plans forwarded for reference are also being returned to you under separate cover.
