I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letters of the 22nd instant, forwarding plans, in duplicate, of superheaters proposed in connection with the above vessels, and I have to inform you that these plans, as shown and amended, will be approved for a working pressure of 215 lb. per sq. inch, provided the steel be made at approved works and tested as required by this Society's Rules, a safety valve be fitted to each part of the superheaters which can be isolated from the boilers, the superheaters be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing, and the whole be tested to three times the working pressure.

One set of the plans is returned herewith, and I shall be obliged if you will furnish me with two copies of each plan submitted for reference purposes in this Office.

I also take this opportunity of enclosing the usual Survey Request Form for completion.
