I return herewith the amended plan, forwarded with your letter of the 25th instant, of the above boiler, and have to inform you that this plan will be approved for a working pressure of 215 lb. per square inch, provided the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates and butt straps, viz:- 31-35 tons per square inch, and of the girder plates, viz:- 29-33 tons per square inch.

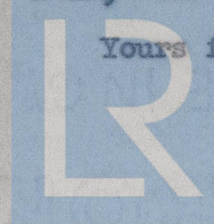
