I enclose a copy of a letter, dated 18th instant, which has been received from the Society's Glasgow Office regarding a proposal to cut openings in the upper deck below the bridge, for ventilation purposes, in the insulated fruit space of the T.S.S. "RODNEY STAR", together with the plan therein referred to.

It will be observed that the Surveyors state they have been informed by a Representative of Messrs. Goodwin, Hamilton & Co., that similar openings were cut in the "AFRIC STAR" and "STUART STAR" when similar alterations were carried out by Messrs. Vickers-Armstrongs, Ltd.

There does not appear to be any record in this Office of the cutting of these openings, nor of the compensation which was required in way of same, and I shall be glad if you will indicate, in pencil, on the enclosed plan the compensation which was required to be provided in the case of these vessels.

Kindly return the enclosed plan with your reply.


