(1928) Ltd., I am desired by Mr. Dickerson to inform you that a plan shewing openings proposed to be cut in the upper deck below the bridge for ventilation purposes in the insulated fruit space has been received in this Office and the Greenock Surveyors state that they have been informed by Mr. Bryant of Messrs. Goodwin, Hamilton & Co. that similar openings were cut in the "AFRIC STAR" and "STUART STAR", when alterations were carried out by Messrs. Vickers-Armstrong & Co., Newcastle-on-Tyne.


In these circumstances, I shall be glad if you will kindly forward any plans or information regarding the openings cut in the latter vessels for reference in dealing with the present submission.
