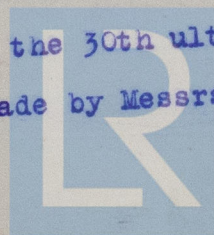
T.S.S. "RODNEY STAR", No. 32662 in the Register Book.

I am desired by Mr. Dickerson to transmit herewith a letter which has been received from Messrs. Wm. Hamilton & Co. (1928) Ltd., from which it will be observed that it is proposed to fill in the forward and after wells of the above vessel and to fit a bow of the Maier form, of which a plan is enclosed.

The fitting of the new bow has the effect of increasing the length of the vessel 30'3" on the load waterline and I have to enquire whether any addition to the main scantlings or equipment numeral will be required on account of the fitting of the new bow. The Builders state that no increase in draft is desired on account of the alterations.

In this connection I think it well to refer you to your letter of the 30th ultimo regarding a somewhat similar proposal made by Messrs. Barclay, Curle & Co.
