

T.S.S. "RODNEY STAR".

It is proposed to fit a "Maier" form bow on the above vessel, and we submit herewith our proposals in connection with same.

The alteration involves the cutting away the fore end of the ship back to approximately No. 1 hold bulkhead, and increasing the length of the ship as shown on enclosed plan.

We understand that with this form of bow no increases are necessary to the basic scantlings and we are submitting our proposals accordingly. We understand also that the equipment will not be increased by this alteration. It has been decided of course to fill in the forward and after wells and the plans for this will be submitted in due course. The filling in of the forward well has been embodied in the enclosed plan.
