S. I am in receipt of your letter of the 29th instant enclosing a cheque for £31. 8. 10 which you have received from Messrs. R. Jobson & Co. Ltd., in payment of the fees and expenses in connexion with the Special Survey of the hull of the Steamer "SILVERBURN", and in reply to your inquiry I have to say that you should issue a receipt to Messrs. Jobson & Co. for the above amount.

At the same time you should inform them that in accordance with the usual practice the certificate of classification would be issued to the Builders, but in view of their request in the matter you are communicating with the Maryport Shipbuilding Co., and upon receiving their sanction in the case, you will be pleased to forward the certificate to Messrs. Jobson at once.

Jobson & Co., and you conclude that it will be in accordance with their wishes for the certificate of classification to be handed to Messrs. Jobson as desired, and you will be glad to learn if this is the case.
