REPAIRS, OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR damage repairs through collision with an unknown steamer on the 8th March 1918.

Bottom cleared, examined and recoiled

On port side forward - No. 1 plate of outerstrake part renewed. No. 2 plate off and faired. No. 3 plate of forecastle side plating renewed with a larger plate. No. 4 plate cropped. Four forecastle frames removed, faired and refitted and three faired in place, port house pipe caulked.

Damage through colliding with quay wall at Bieppe 28th Feb 1918.

On port side - No. 1 plate in 4th & 5th strakes below sheer indented and caulking of landing edge started, caulking now made good.

No. 4 plate of outerstrake, Nos. 3 & 4 in 1st and 2nd strakes below sheer

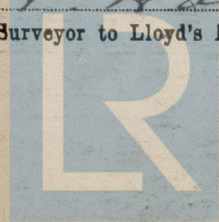
