T.S. MOTOR VESSEL "SEBASTIAN" N.W.C. RPT No. 68893

This vessel was built in 1914 and fitted with twin screw two stroke cycle oil engines manufactured by Messrs. the Akt Diesels Motorer Stockholm. As these engines did not give satisfaction they have now been taken out and twin screw oil engines of the four stroke cycle type manufactured by the Werkspoor Co. at Amsterdam have now been fitted.

The high pressure air and fuel receivers were not made in Holland and there being no Surveyor at the place where they were manufactured, the Society's requirements as to the testing of the materials could not be carried out, the receivers have however been tested to 150 atmospheres by the Amsterdam Surveyors and found satisfactory, they however recommend they they should be replaced at the Owners' earliest convenience by new receivers manufactured in accordance with the Society's Rules.

It is submitted that this vessel is eligible for the record of :- \*LMC 6.16 \* NE 6.16 Oil engines 4SC.SA. 12 cy 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " -35 $\frac{7}{16}$ " Werkspoor

Both NS 6.16 Note 2 DB 150 lbs to remain in the Register Book.

It is submitted that this vessel is eligible to remain as classed, subject to the 2 H.P. air injection and the 2 H.P. fuel receivers being <sup>replaced</sup> renewed by others manufactured in accordance with the Rules of this Society at the Owners earliest convenience.
