Gentlemen,

With reference to Mr. Carnaghan's letter of the 26th ultimo, respecting the fees for the survey of the machinery of Messrs. The Galedon Shipbuilding & Engineering Co's No. 232 vessel ("SEBASTIAN"), I have to send herewith for your information and guidance a copy of a letter which has this day been addressed to the Society's Surveyor at Stockholm on the subject, from which you will observe that the Surveyor has been informed that in the circumstances the sum of £14:6:8 should be credited to the Dundee account for the survey of the erection of the engines on board, trials, etc.

I have to add that in this case you should charge only the first entry fee and the fee for the survey of the boiler so far as the machinery is concerned.
