The "Violette" has been in Dry Dock since the 28th January, and expense is still going on, so that a decision is very necessary.

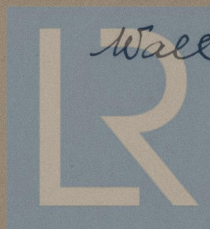
