Nature of Survey

The Halifax Surveyor report this vessel to have been examined in dry dock after having sustained extensive damage through stranding.

Recommendations have been made for permanent repairs but the vessel has been removed from the dry dock and beached and it has not yet been decided whether repairs will be effected or whether the vessel will be considered as a constructive total loss.

In the Surveyor's opinion the vessel is not now in a fit condition, or eligible, to remain as classed.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be expunged from the Register Book and "Stranded - In port damaged, 5.21" inserted.
