This vessel was built to the order of
the Emery Steamship Co., (Messrs. John S Emery & Co. Inc.)
and later was sold to the Union Sulphur Company, and was
lost early in 1921.

A letter from Messrs. Emery requesting the
omission of one of the watertight bulkheads required by the
Rules is attached to the first entry report on the ship, and
in the circumstances it is submitted that a copy of that letter
might be furnished to Mr. J.R.Gordon as desired by him.
