I have to confirm the cablegram sent you yesterday respecting the Steamer "ISLEWORTH", and to acknowledge the receipt of your reply thereto, which being decoded read as follows, namely:-

S e n t.

"Isleworth now at Vatica Bay having been ashore and fore  
"end has been removed by blasting cable whether there are  
"proper facilities for repairing permanently such damage  
"at your port matter very urgent".

"Isleworth referring to your cable of 22nd instant proper  
"facilities for repairing permanently equal to requirements  
"for new construction not available but efficient permanent  
"repairs can be carried out Stop. Should Owners decide  
"permanent repairs Piraeus and vessel has large plates these  
"together bulb angle frame stem bars must be purchased  
"abroad and to Owners account first instance owing to  
"present exchange restriction."
