Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, respecting the fees chargeable for the survey during construction of the Hull and Machinery of the Steamer "TRAVEAL" (Glasgow First Entry Report No. 39118) up to the time of transfer to private ownership, and with regard thereto have to inform you that the proportion of the fees which will be chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for the survey of the Hull will be 25% of the difference between the fees as a Standard Vessel and the ordinary classification fees, and for the survey of the Machinery 75%, viz:-

For survey of Hull.....	£20.	0.	0.
" " " Machinery.....	51.	0.	0.

An account has to-day been rendered to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding for these fees, and, on payment, your account will be credited accordingly.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly see that the necessary entries are now made in the Glasgow Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
