Your Ref:- 'S' - s.s. "BLACK OSPREY"

We regret that your letter of 1st May enclosing account against the above steamer for Survey Fees amounting to £128.0.0. has been overlooked, owing to press of other matters.

We presume, however, that this charge should be claimed by you from the Ministry of Shipping, on whose behalf we temporarily were registered as owners of the ship.

It is true that vessel never reached the U.K. to be transferred to the Ministry, but this has already happened with other vessels lost before transfer, and some method of procedure has no doubt been settled for such cases, if the fees have not already been paid in U.S.A.
