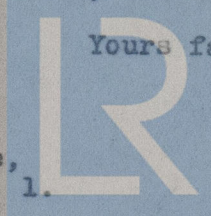
The plans have been carefully examined and are found to be in order, and I have the pleasure to return the same herewith, duly signed and stamped.
