I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Barrow have forwarded to this Office a copy of the order which has been placed by the Builders with The Atlas Diesel Co. Ltd. for the machinery for the above vessel, and as it is understood that the engines will be made by Messrs. British Auxiliaries Ltd., Glasgow, the order is enclosed for the Surveyors' information.

In this connexion I shall be glad if the Surveyors will advise the Engine Makers that the spare gear mentioned on the order form does not comply with Notice No. 168 (Additions and Amendments to the Rules), which became valid on October 23rd, 1936, the following items being omitted from the list:-

- 1 cylinder relief valve.
- 1 complete cylinder liner
- 1 set of wheels for the camshaft drive, or six separate links with pins and rollers where chain drive is used for camshaft or scavenge blowers.
- 1 set of rubber rings for liner joints.
- 1 complete crank pin bearing.
- 1 set of pads of each hand for one face of
Michell Thrust Block.
