M. I have to acknowledge the receipt of Mr. Bennett's letter of the 4th instant, enclosing one from Messrs. Russell & Co., together with a copy of one from the Owners of their s.s. No. 883 ("OSWEGO"), requesting the adoption of the arrangement of bulkheads proposed by the Builders in the case of this vessel, and in reply thereto I am directed to state that in the circumstances the arrangement of bulkheads as desired will be approved, and that on completion the following notation will be made in the Society's Register Book:- "One intermediate bulkhead and one 'tween deck bulkhead dispensed with; 5 bkds. to upper deck; 1 bkd. to second deck only."

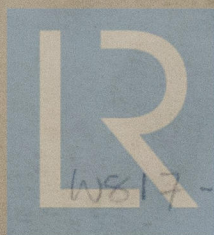
The plans forwarded with your letter are retained, as per your telegram of this afternoon.
