I return Certificates herewith, and shall be glad if you will explain the matter to the builders in due course.

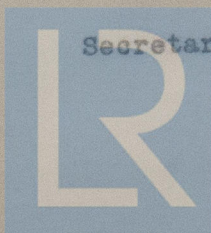
