I beg to forward a letter received from Messrs The Clyde S. & E. Co., Ltd., with reference to the H.P. Cylinder of S.S. "LANDONIA", Greenock Report No. 17186, and with regard thereto would point out that the statements in the letter are as noted on the Report (the Cylinder was tested to full working pressure by steam, and found tight); and, while the patch is good and efficient, the commercial value of the machinery is affected by such a patch, and the present Owner took exception to a patched Cylinder - hence the recommendation to fit a new Cylinder at the first convenient opportunity.
