I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo forwarding the plans of the Wood Sailing Vessel "HYASTON", (Your First Entry Report No. 319), and with regard thereto I shall be glad if you will be good enough to furnish fresh particulars of the following items, as the particulars given in the report do not agree with those given on the approved plans:-

Siding and moulding of floors, foothooks and top timbers.

Size of second deck beams.

Width and thickness of upper deck plating.

Size and number of bilge logs.

Diameter of bolts in deck shelves.

Number of planks between butts on the same timber.

Length of stream chain.

I shall be glad if you will also state if pumps are fitted as required, and if so whether they are satisfactory, and also if the ceiling is edge bolted, and if the wales are
