Dear Sir,

I beg to enclose herewith report of survey on the Eastern Shipbuilding Co.'s Barquantine "HYASTAN" which has been duly completed to my satisfaction.

When the vessel was launched she was named "ARMENIA", but as the Registrar of Shipping would not agree to her having that name, she has since been re-named "HYASTAN". In the meantime the vessel has been assigned by the Board of Trade a freeboard of $44\frac{1}{4}$ " from statutory deck line to centre of disc, but the Owner also desires to have a freeboard assigned to the vessel by Lloyd's Register. I am therefore enclosing herewith freeboard form "a" partly filled in with all particulars necessary for working out the freeboard by the Tables, and shall be obliged if you will issue a freeboard to the vessel and forward me particulars of same.
