I have to acquaint you that in November last, the Society's Surveyors at Hull reported that a bower anchor belonging to the Steamer "FRENCH ROSE" had been taken ashore to be repaired, and in February the Owners wrote that the anchor was put on board at Deptford after having been tested at Sunderland.
