Vessel examined in Dry Dock. Bottoms cleaned & coated. The stem & stem plating were found to be slightly bent over between 12'-0" & 20'-0" draught marks. The riveting & caulking in way of same have now been overhauled as a temporary repair and in the Surveyors' opinion permanent repairs may be effected at Owners' convenience.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed with record of Survey 9-'16 as recommended subject as above.
