S. I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under consideration your letter of the 22nd instant, addressed to the Society's Office at Newcastle, relative to your steamer "GRANCEMOOR", and, in reply, I have to say that in view of the year's grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Special Survey No. I of the steamer having already been exceeded, the Committee regret they cannot agree to your proposal to defer the matter for a further twelve months.

They have, however, agreed to the steamer's class being retained for the present, and as the remaining requirements of the survey do not necessitate dry-docking, the Committee suggest that the remaining part of the survey should be complied with as opportunity offers in the near future.
