TELEGRAM RECEIVED:- "EUPION" report 14298 wire immediately whether bottom plating clear of oil tanks is cemented".

TELEGRAM SENT:- "EUPION" report 14298 bottom plating clear of oil tanks cemented".

I may add that clear of the oil spaces, abaft oil fuel bunkers, in freight hold, and in the fore and after peaks the bottom plating is cemented and above the cement the surfaces are coated with red lead and zinc, ~~also~~ I regret that I omitted to mention the cementing.
