OR EXAMINATION AS PER RULE, FOR Damage by grounding in the Gambia River on 16/5/16 by weather on 14th & 15th Oct 1916 and part S.S. N° 2.

The repairs:- The vessel examined in dry dock, bottoms cleaned & recoated and a number of rivets in R-1 and 2 keel plates renewed. The rudder lifted, pintles bed, steering gear connections overhauled. At fore end bridge, one bridge side has been fitted with a large doubling on port & starboard sides also 2 large bridge brackets fitted to bulwark rail bar. 2 bulwark plates repaired aft. Minor repairs Sout. Part S.S. R-2:- The bottom & rudder examined in dry dock, now in condition. The steering gear connections examined. The cables ranged and the class overhauled. The chain locker & all cargo holds above the close ceiling new & found satisfactory. A general examination of the bunkers as far as P.T.O.
