Sent 8.7.21.


"Cablegram regarding 'HEWITT' received and will be acted upon".

Harrington, Bigham & Englar, Counsellors at Law, a letter stating that they were in receipt of a cablegram requesting them to ascertain whether Owners steamer "HEWITT" ex "PACIFIC" or former Owners "PACIFIC" applied Lloyd's for freeboard and if so what freeboard assigned, and on the 1st July we replied to them as follows:-
