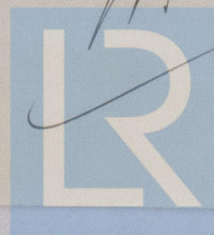

Nature of Survey

DAMAGE.

This vessel is reported by the *Genoa* Surveyors to have sustained damage through *striking submerged object*. Temporary repairs have been effected to <sup>their</sup> ~~his~~ satisfaction to enable the vessel to proceed on her voyage to *Barry dock* where it is proposed to effect the necessary permanent repairs.

It is submitted the *Barry* Surveyors should be requested to give the case the necessary attention on the vessel's arrival at their port, and in the meantime, the class might be allowed to remain undisturbed.
