M I have to inform you that a first entry report has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle on the new steamer "CLIBURN", built by Messrs. R. Williamson & Son, of Workington, from which it appears that this vessel is proceeding to Glasgow where the machinery is to be fitted on board, and that in order to complete the survey for classification the engine and boiler casings require to be riveted up, the mizzen mast to step and rig, the after capstan to fit, the steering gear to complete and examine, and the steam pump suction and bawlers and warps to examine and check.

I shall be glad if the Surveyors will give the matter the necessary attention, and forward a Report on Form 8 in due course with a view to the classification of the vessel.
