The Glasgow Surveyors should be informed the vessel is proceeding to their port where the machinery is to be fitted and that in order to complete the survey for classification, the Engine & Boiler casing requires to be riveted up, engine mast to step & rig, after capstan to fit, steering gear to complete & examine & the steam pump suction & hangers swamps to examine & check.
